The Schedule

The Race Weekend begins on Friday, May 4th with a Runner's Expo.

This expo provides a race kit pick up and a last minute registration opportunity from 11:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Port Credit Memorial Arena. All are welcome to check out what the friendly vendors have to offer!

Saturday

► On Saturday, May 5th, the Runner's Expo continues from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

► At 6:00 p.m. the Pasta Dinner at the Novotel Toronto Mississauga Centre will offer you a great carb loading experience prior to your run.

► Also at 6:00 p.m., "The Hazel" 5K will take off at Lakeshore Road and Front Street North, near the famous Port Credit Lighthouse.

► The Valeant Pharmaceuticals 10K and the 10K Student Relay both start at 6:30 p.m. from Lakeshore Road and Johnson's Lane.

Sunday

► The Full Marathon, Petrillo Law Corporate/Team Relay, and Half Marathon all start at 7:30 a.m. from Robert Speck and City Centre Drive, near Square One.

► Registered participants in all of the above events as well as the Valeant Pharmaceuticals 10K Run/Walk will receive an Under Armour performance shirt this year as part of their race kit!

► Don't forget about our enjoyable 2K Fun Run/Walk which begins at 12:30 p.m.
